Steve Gray, Sr., 157, Clarksboro, N.J./Kingsway Regional... Three-year letterman...veteran who has battled injuries throughout his career, yet has remained a positive impact on the program with his enthusiasm and love of the sport...holds a career record of 15-20 (.435) in three different weight classes...career pins: 6...majoring in management...**2006-2007 (Junior)**

Year): posted a 5-7 overall record in two difference weight classes...missed six weeks due to an injury but did come back to wrestle two matches late in the season to fill in a void in the lineup at 165...went 5-5 at 157 and 0-2 at 165...after losing his first match in the season-opening Monarch Invitational (King's College), came back to win three straight, including one by pin, before losing a 6-0 decision to eventually third-place finisher Mark Berber of Ursinus College...also won two of four matches, including one by pin, at the Washington & Lee invitational...**2005-2006 (Sophomore Year):** posted a 3-6 record in two different weight classes...an injury kept him out of the lineup for two months...ended the season by finishing sixth at 157 pounds at the Middle Atlantic Conference championships...wrestled at 157 pounds in his final seven events after going 1-1 at 149 pounds at the season-opening Monarch Invitational (King's College) in November...registered the second pin of his career **(Gray continued)**

against Wilkes University in a dual-meet on Feb. 11...**2004-2005 (Freshman Year):** posted a 7-7 mark in two different weight classes: was 4-4 at 149 and 3-3 at 157...registered three pins, including the first of his career at 149 pounds at the Red Dragon Invitational at Oneonta State on November 20; won three of five matches in that event.
