Profile: Four-year letter-winner...finished her career with a 36-24 record in singles (.600) and 31-24 in doubles (.564)...posted winning records in singles three times and doubles twice in

her career...finished her career sixth in singles victories (36), 10th in singles winning percentage (.600), and sixth in doubles wins (31) and doubles winning percentage (.564) in Scranton history...**2008 (Senior Year):** Led the Royals in singles victories (11)...went 6-0 in singles against Landmark Conference opponents...was named first-team all-Landmark Conference in singles and second-team in doubles...was 4-1 in the number two spot and 7-3 in the number three position in singles in the Royal lineup...defeated Corinne Alcorn of Catholic University, 6-0, 6-0, to help Scranton to a 6-3 victory in the semifinals of the Landmark Conference tournament on April 22...teamed with Sarah Costello to defeat Lindsey Hopper and Dyana Swan of Moravian, 8-2, in the Royals' 6-3 loss in the Landmark Conference championship match...was 5-1 in singles matches decided in three sets...went 2-0 in singles and 1-1 in doubles during the fall portion of the schedule...both of her wins in singles came in the number three position in the lineup: defeated Jillian Tallarico of King's, 7-6 (7-4), 4-6, 1-0 (10-2) and Erika Niemann of Lycoming, 6-1, 6-0...teamed with sophomore Deirdre Wylie to defeat Rebecca Reynolds and Amiee Snyder, 8-2, at the number one doubles in Scranton's 9-0 victory over Lycoming on Sept. 22 at the Poly Hi Tennis Courts...**2006 (Junior Year):** finished the year with a 3-8 record in singles and 4-8 mark in doubles...played all of her matches at the number one spot in the lineup...opened the season with singles victories over Nicol Douglas of Baptist Bible and Emma Smith of Elizabethtown...played all of her double matches with one partner, fellow junior Sarah Costello...**2005 (Sophomore Year):** posted a 9-6 record in singles and 10-4 mark in doubles...played 13 of her 15 singles matches at the number two spot and all 14 of her doubles matches at the number one position in the lineup...posted a 6-0, 6-0 win over Alex Holzman in a 7-2 victory over Drew University in the semifinals of the Freedom Conference tournament on October 15 at the Poly Hi Tennis Courts...in a 5-4 loss to DeSales in the championship match of the Freedom Conference team tournament on October 16, teamed with Maggie Leuzarder to defeat Laura LeVan and Liz Guidon, 8-5, at the number one doubles...won five of her first six singles and four of her first six doubles matches of the season...defeated Sarah Boynton of Susquehanna, 8-2, in the quarterfinals of Flight 2 at the Middle Atlantic Conference individual championships before ending the season with a 6-3, 7-5 loss to Alison McDonald of Wilkes in the semifinals...

2004 (Freshman Year): earned second-team all-Freedom Conference honors...posted a 13-6 record in singles and an 11-4 mark in doubles...won 10 of her final 13 matches in singles competition...posted straight set victories over Elizabeth Zell of Widener, Beth Ann Hill of King's and Erin Jessen of Drew and a 7-5, 2-6 (10-6) win over Lisa Abel of Elizabethtown to win the Flight 4 title at the Middle Atlantic Conference individual championships...teamed with Kristin Bellino to win three matches at the MAC individual championships to capture the Flight 2 doubles title...won both of her singles matches in the first-ever Freedom Conference team tournament...recorded straight set victories over Stephanie Garrett of Hood, Stephanie Kennedy of Catholic University and Jamie Valis of Marywood to win the Capital Fall Classic Flight 4 singles title.
