

The current number of required credits exceeds that of most other concentrations; as a result the number of enrolled students has remained small. The fact that most students add the concentration fairly late in their academic career, usually after taking a course in the concentration, makes it difficult to complete it as now structured, and this will be even more true if the total number of credits for graduation is lowered.


